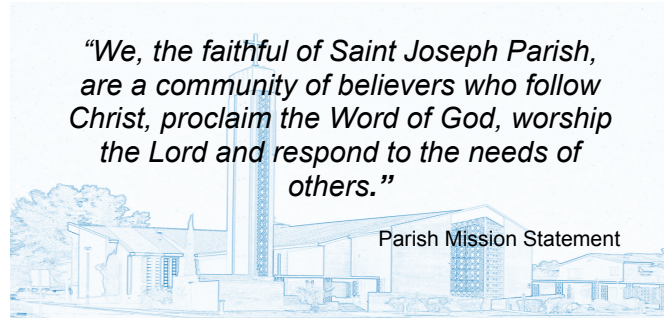

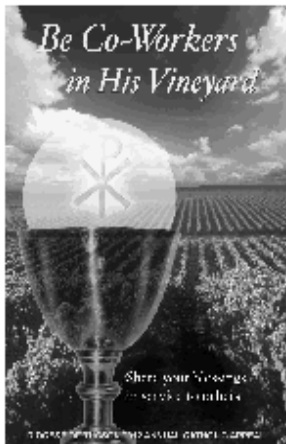

VINE OF GRACE RETREAT MINISTRY

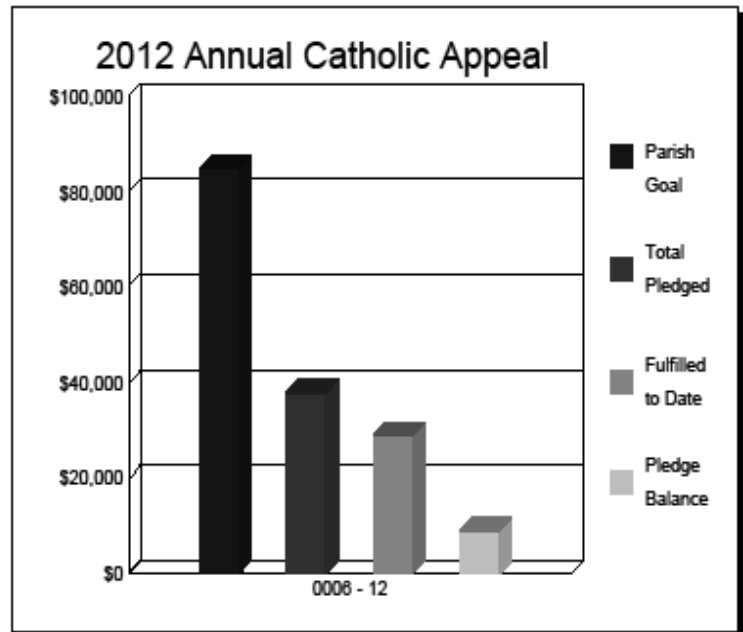
